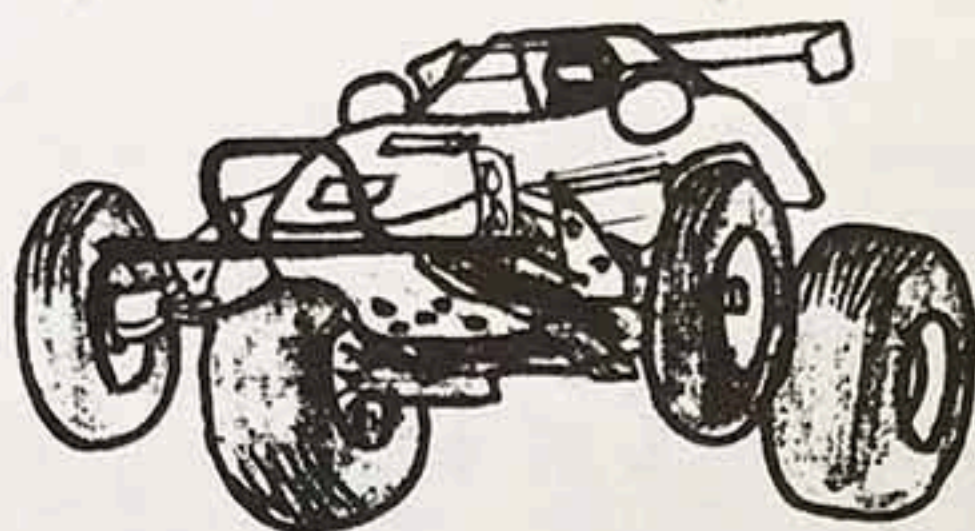

# WELCOME – WILLKOMMEN – BIENVENU


Friends,

# **YORKSHIRE RADIO CONTROLLED MODEL CAR RACING CLUB**

The Yorkshire R.C.M.C.R.C. has been promoting model car racing for 14 years, first in Bradford and more recently at our own racing complex in Halifax adjacent to the North Bridge Leisure Centre. Two of our members were present at the inaugural meeting of the British Radio Car Association and we have maintained close links ever since. Two of our racing members were successful last year, winning the European Championships in  $\frac{1}{8}$  circuit racing and the British  $\frac{1}{8}$  Off-Road Championships. Although racing nationally in most scales, league and club racing still occupies most of our time, and at these meetings our more experienced members have the time to give advice and information to newcomers and visitors who are always welcome. During the winter months we race electrics indoors at the Leisure Centre, which is also the scene of our monthly business meetings. In addition to racing we organise social events throughout the year and do exhibitions and galas when time allows. Some of our race meetings are open to non-members on payment of an entry fee but in general our outdoor circuits are for the use of club members only. In addition to racing facilities club membership provides free third party insurance and a monthly newsletter to keep you in touch. 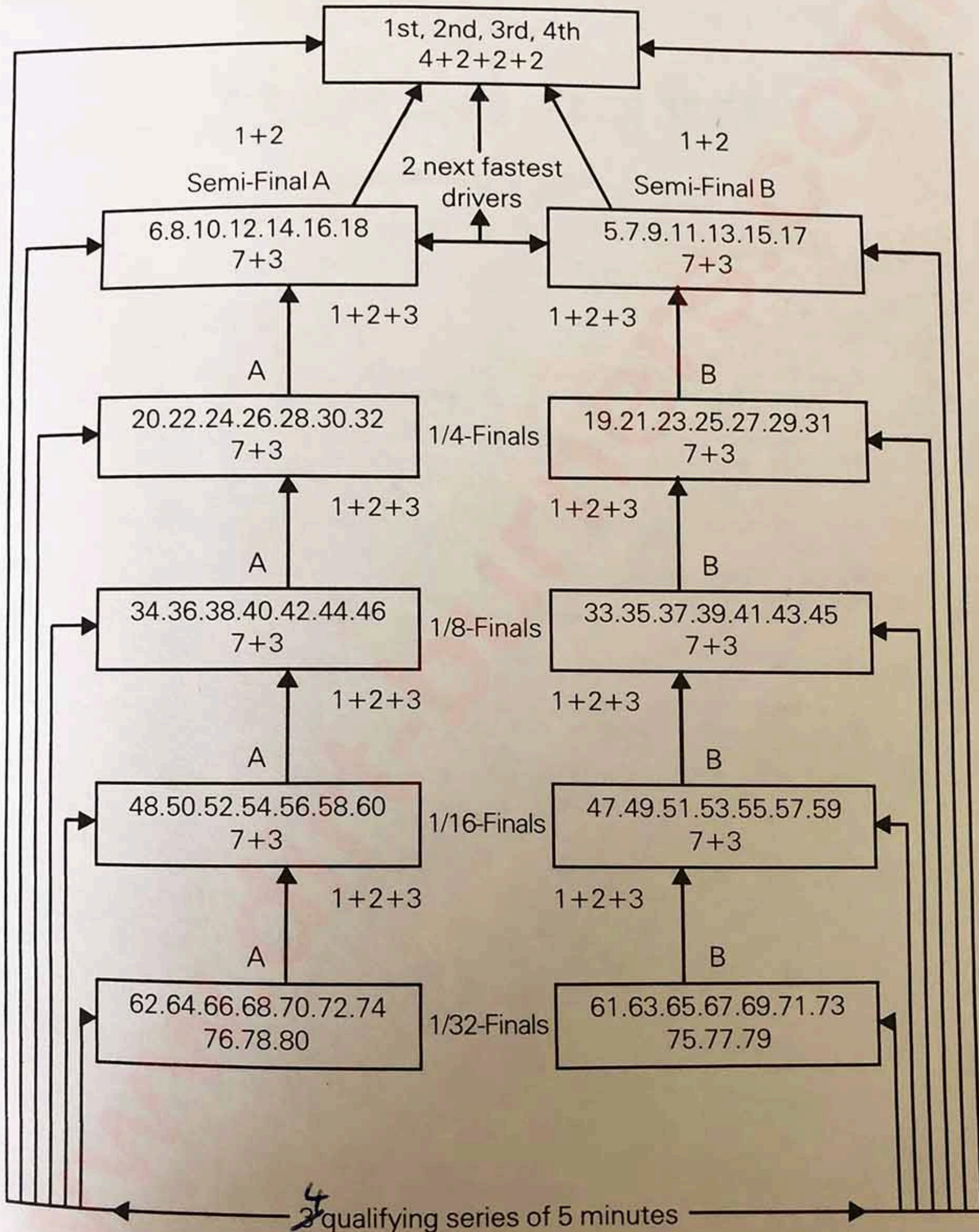

The British Radio Car Association was formed in 1972 to promote interest in radio controlled model racing cars, to set rules and standards for construction and racing and to encourage national and international competition.

The Association has grown to be one of the major world associations and, in co-operation with the European Federation of Radio-operated Automobiles (E.F.R.A.) and the International Federation of Model Auto Racing (I.F.M.A.R.) has taken a leading part in establishing world standards and international competition for eighth and twelfth scale track and eighth and tenth scale off road R/C cars.

The Association circulates its own publication "Circuit Chatter" regularly throughout the year, with national and international racing news, members' news and views and all the latest information for the R/C car enthusiast.

To encourage racing at all levels of cost and driver-ability the Association publishes regular national handicap ratings for all drivers competing in open events, enabling organisers to stage open competitions with the attraction that each driver is graded with drivers of similar ability.

The annual membership fee covers enrolment, an Association Handbook with all the latest construction and racing rules, insurance cover for all British member drivers and regular delivery of "Circuit Chatter" by post.
