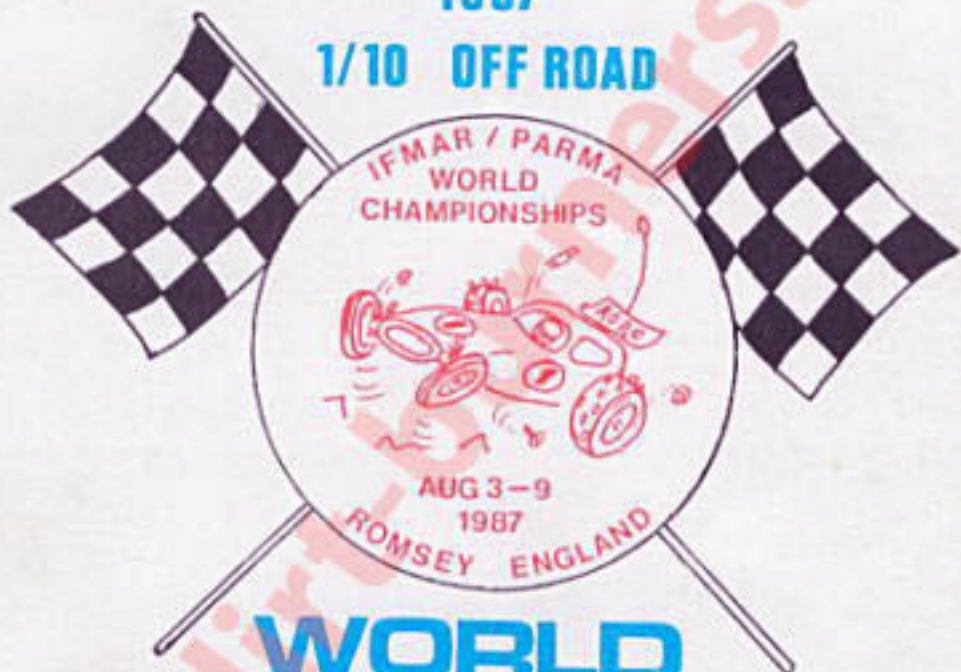

INTRODUCTION

Welcome to Romsey and the second IFMAR World Championships for 1/10th scale off-road electric R/C buggies. We hope you will find this magazine interesting, informative and enjoyable.

Also that the racing is fun to watch and that you find it as exciting as the racers themselves.

A special welcome to the many people visiting us from overseas and to the various companies who have helped us to stage this event by sponsoring us and taking advertising space around the track and in this magazine.

The meeting is spread over a period of seven days starting on Monday 3rd August with the 2WD Championship. This event reaches its climax on Wednesday afternoon when we will be crowning the new 2WD World Champion. Thursday is a day off for everyone, with the action resuming first thing Friday morning with the 4WD championship. This will be decided by Sunday afternoon with the 4WD World Finals. Winners of each event will be presented with their laurels immediately after the finals on Wednesday and Sunday, but the main trophies will be presented at the banquet on Sunday evening.

The event is run to IFMAR rules. IFMAR being the worlds governing body for all R/C model car racing, and the only organisation able to sanction an official World Championship.

Winners will receive their laurels at the track immediately after the Finals. Trophies will be presented at the WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP BANQUET on the evening of Sunday 9th August at the Jubilee Hall.

Each competitor races in six qualifying heats. His fastest single qualifying time determines which final he will be in. There will be ten cars to each final, therefore the top ten qualifiers will compete in the three legged A-Final to decide the 1987 Champion of the World. Each competitor in the A-Final will not only be racing to win each leg, but will also have to record as fast a race time as possible as the best two race times out of the three will be counted. These times are added together to find the new World Champion. In the event of rain between any of the three legs of the final the positions will be determined on a points basis. All results will be checked before the official announcements.
